Yael Segal is one of Vancouver's emerging young Jewish leaders. Yael currently dedicates her time, energy, passion, and expertise to a number of Jewish causes, including serving as Co-Chair of the Jewish Federation of Greater Vancouver's Ben Gurion Society; serving on the Board of Chabad of Richmond; and lending her time to Jewish Family Services, performing food bank deliveries and by utilizing her native Russian tongue to provide comfort to lonely, isolated Russian-speaking seniors.



In August 2020, Yael and her husband Justin founded the Justin & Yael Segal Family Fund, with the goal of enriching and empowering Jewish youth in Europe and Israel.

Recently, Yael organized an outdoor exercise boot camp series in response to the recent conflict between Hamas and Israel, uniting Vancouver's young Jewish community and raising thousands of dollars to benefit JNF Canada's Israel Under Attack 2021 initiative. In June 2021, Yael was honoured by Jewish Federation of Greater Vancouver (JFGV) with the Lou Zimmerman Award in recognition of her exemplary leadership for her work in revitalizing and nurturing JFGV's Ben Gurion Society for young Jewish philanthropists.
